Align Your Wheels

All of the elements that make your car go straight are called "alignment." Wheel alignment is important to the health of your vehicle. Proper wheel alignment makes a vehicle steer easily and allows tires to wear evenly.

Three things affect wheel alignment: caster, camber and toe. Caster is the angle the wheel pivots on. Camber describes how vertical the wheel is in relation to the ground. Toe is how "pigeon-toed" the wheels are. If your vehicle's caster, camber, or toe is off, they must be readjusted as soon as possible.

When your vehicle is brought in for an alignment, it is placed on a platform, which allows the wheels to spin while a computer calculates orientation. The computer compares this to a database of manufacturer specifications for the year, make and model of the car. If wheel alignment is off, an adjustment is made and the vehicle is tested again until the wheels are aligned to specifications.

When a vehicle is driven in a straight line, the wheels on the left side of the vehicle should be parallel with the wheels on the right. If one wheel is slightly off this axis, the vehicle may want to pull, or drift, to that side.

It is recommended that your wheels be aligned every 10,000 miles or at least once a year. If it has been a while since your last wheel alignment, your wheels may have misaligned. Visit us at VW Springfield to have your wheels realigned!
