Change Your Fuel Filter

The main function of a fuel filter is to filter out debris particles and contaminants from flowing fuel. Fuel filters are a common addition to automotive engines, where they are placed in varied locations between a car's fuel tank and its carburetor or fuel injection system. Fuel filters ensure that gasoline entering a car's engine is as clean and pure as possible.

Due to the differences in fuel delivery systems, fuel filters come in different sizes. Most fuel filters are constructed out of special heat-resistant paper mesh enclosed in metal or plastic covering.

Fuel filters should be changed at least once a year. A dirty or clogged fuel filter can cause poor vehicle performance or prevent a vehicle from being started.

Regular maintenance of your car's fuel filter is a necessary part of the overall maintenance of your vehicle. Stop by the Discount Service Center to get your fuel filter checked or replaced.
