Turn Signals

Turn signals are standard features in cars. They allow drivers to signal their intentions before turning, which allows other drivers to adjust. Failing to signal before changing lanes or turning corners can result in serious accidents.

Although turn signals may appear to be a simple part of the car, they are actually more complex. Turn signals use the steering shaft as its main system component. A hub is attached to the steering shaft and has grooves in it. When the turn signal lever is used, the light in the back of the car begins to blink. As you turn the wheel, it lets the turn signal lever slip over the grooves. Once you turn the wheel the opposite direction, it pushes the lever off and a spring pushes it back to its original position.

Non-working turn signals are dangerous while on the road. Without working signals, it becomes difficult to alert other drivers of your intentions. As a result, this could potentially lead to a serious accident. Extreme caution should be exercised while driving with non-working turn signals.

In case your turn signals are not working or malfunctioning, stop by the Discount Service Center Service Department to have them inspected and repaired!
